2026-2027 Scholarship Application

Purpose: To assist students from Christian families involved in harness racing in continuing their education by providing financial aid to worthy applicants. CHHA sponsors the John & Janet Klark Memorial Scholarship and the Rambling Willie Scholarship. Other memorial scholarships will become available as they are funded and there may be other named scholarships.

Award amount: Variable depending on availability of funding.

Eligibility: Available to graduating high school seniors and/or students enrolled in an educational institution of higher learning. Students who demonstrate a strong commitment to their Christian faith and are involved in harness racing are encouraged to apply. The Scholarship Committee gives special attention to how the applicant demonstrates his/her Christian faith in daily living and his/her involvement in harness racing, in addition to financial need and the course of study the applicant is undertaking. Students must be full-time and may be enrolled in degree or certificate programs. Graduate students are not eligible.

Application deadline: Applications and attachments must be postmarked or emailed on or before **May 31, 2026**. **Emailed applications are preferred**. For paper submissions, mail application and attachments to:
